- Use Statewide Hotline if your county is not listed.
- Include your name, county and a brief but detailed report of your concern or question.
- 1. If you do not receive a response within 20 minutes, text one of the statewide Hotline numbers.
- 2. If your question or concern is immediate and serious, CALL your county hotline; if no answer, CALL statewide hotline.
